WP Objectives

- 1. To identify the relevant skills, knowledge and approaches needed to design and implement performance based activities to engage young people with research and to facilitate mutual learning amongst partners and external experts Knowledge Sharing Workshop Task. 3.1
- 2. To **develop training modules and guidelines for researchers and teachers** based on the results of the research carried out on the first phase of implementation of PERSEIA activities in order to prepare them to independently carry out PERSEIA activities and to develop cross-disciplinary skills associated with PERSEIAS such as communication and engagement skills, team working and a more holistic and interdisciplinary understanding of research, including RRI values and social inclusion amongst others. *Training and guidelines for researchers and teachers Tasks* 3.2 and 3.3

WP Tasks

Task 3.1 Development of knowledge sharing workshop on performance-based activities and RRI values (Input from task 2.1 and from all the partners experiences)

- 1- partners to identify skills and knowledge needed for production of PERSEIAS (focus groups) and reflect on own expertise.
- 2- knowledge sharing workshop involving partners, secondary school students, teachers, early career researchers and external experts if needed.
- 3- information collated during the workshop to inform the development of PERSEIAS as well as tasks 3.2 and 3.3.

+some of the skills may be for example: performance skills, working with schools and teenagers, participatory approaches, ethics in participatory research, evaluation, responsible research and innovation...

WP Tasks

Task 3.2 Development of training and guidelines for researchers (input from task 2.2, 4.3 and 4.4 and also from evaluation of researchers)

- 1- training developed in collaboration with AJA and UoW. Specific topics will depend on results of research done during implementation of PERSEIAS.
- 2-training delivered in UK (Bristol), France and Spain, in different formats. Development of toolkit.
- 3- training evaluated by UoW and UoB.
- 4- development / redesign of new training
- 5- training delivered in UK (Bristol), France and Spain, in different formats. Testing of the toolkit.
- 6- toolkit evaluated by UoW and UoB
- 7- design of the final toolkit aimed at institutions involved in training of researchers

WP Tasks

Task 3.3 Development of training and guidelines for teachers (input from task 2.2, 4.3 and 4.4 and also from our own evaluation of teachers)

- 1- a training for teachers will be developed in parallel to the training for researchers and in collaboration with AJA. Specific topics will depend on results of research done during implementation of PERSEIAS.
- 2- pilot training tested with secondary school teachers in Bristol. First version of the toolkit developed.
- 3- other trainings delivered in each of the countries involved in close collaboration with local partners
- 4- training evaluated by UoB.
- 5- development / redesign of new training
- 6- Trainings delivered in UK (Bristol), France and Spain by local partners. Testing of the first version of the toolkit.
- 7- toolkit evaluated by UoB
- 8- design of the final toolkit aimed at teachers
