Preparation of the review meeting with the PO in November 6th— How will it be addressed?

1. **WP1**: Isabel Ruiz-Mallén (UOC) explained that the meeting will be organised in the same way that the previous meeting. First, UOC will introduce the general objectives and methodology of the project and show the relevant results according to each objective for the reported period (M16-M36), as well as main numbers related to the impact.

EUSEA suggested to put students' testimonies (sentences) gathered through the project in the walls of the room.

2. **WP3:** Martha Crean from UoB showed the presentation.

CT asked mentioning the partners that participated in the trainings. It was also suggested to put numbers of teachers and ECR participating.

The CT asked UoB to include a screenshot of the toolkit at the website.

3. **WP2:** Helena Gonzalez from TBVT made the presentation.

The CT suggested to add tasks 2.2 and 2.3 and to reorder the presentation. Also, it was suggested to add more information at the beginning regarding Task 2.1 and Perseias, explaining what a Perseia is and the different approaches (Science Busk, stand-up comedy, clown).

The CT asked to replace the term "toolkits" by "protocols" that it is the one employed in the DoA.

4. WP4: María Heras from UAB showed a draft of the presentation.

The CT reminded to include scientific publications, the book chapter and pictures on the Reflective sessions to the presentation.

5. **WP6:** Andrea Troncoso from EUSEA made the presentation.
